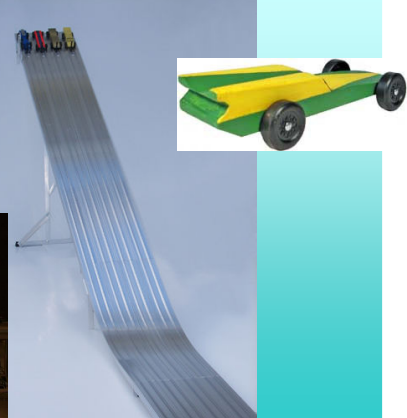




New Pinewood Derby Track

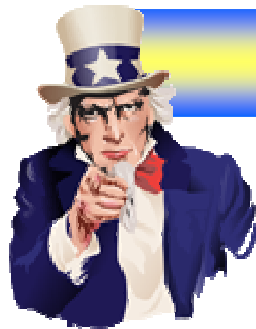

- Lion and Tiger Den Leaders** - Usually a parent from the new den will step up, however we will always take a volunteer from the Pack.

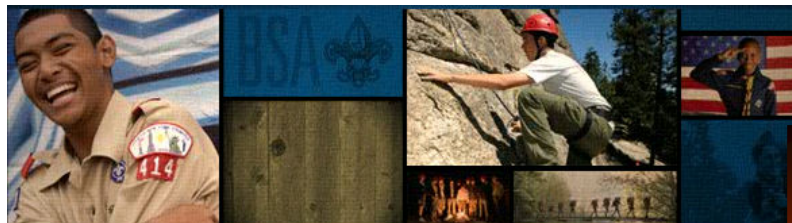

To qualify for the Summertime Pack Award and the Quality Unit Award we need you to have **"Fun in the Sun"** with Pack 300 this Summer.

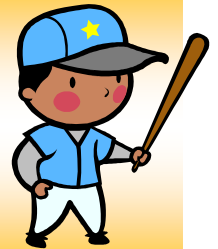
